- **What does a priest do?**
 1. **Teach the people**
 2. **Serve as judge to resolve controversy**
 3. **Offer sacrifices for forgiveness of sins**
 4. **Assess impurity**
 5. **Bless the people and bless God**
 6. **Take care of the meeting places**
(Tent/Tabernacle/Temple)
 7. **High Priests: supreme civil leaders; oversaw the other priests, inquired of the Lord on behalf of**

the people, and offered the annual Day of Atonement sacrifice for all.

- **Hebrews 8:1-3 - “8 Now the main point of what we are saying is this: We do have such a high priest, who sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven,² and who serves in the sanctuary, the true tabernacle set up by the Lord, not by a mere human being.³ Every high priest is appointed to offer both gifts and sacrifices, and so it was necessary for this one also to have something to offer.”**
- **Hebrews 8:6 ”⁶ But in fact the ministry Jesus has received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of**

which he is mediator is superior to the old one, since the new covenant is established on better promises.”

- **Hebrews 8:7-13 ⁷ For if there had been nothing wrong with that first covenant, no place would have been sought for another. ⁸ But God found fault with the people and said[a]:**

**“The days are coming, declares the Lord,
when I will make a new covenant
with the people of Israel
and with the people of Judah.**

**⁹ It will not be like the covenant
I made with their ancestors
when I took them by the hand**

**to lead them out of Egypt,
because they did not remain faithful to my covenant,
and I turned away from them,
declares the Lord.**

**¹⁰ This is the covenant I will establish with the people
of Israel**

after that time, declares the Lord.

**I will put my laws in their minds
and write them on their hearts.**

**I will be their God,
and they will be my people.**

**11 No longer will they teach their neighbor,
or say to one another, ‘Know the Lord,’
because they will all know me,
from the least of them to the greatest.**

**12 For I will forgive their wickedness
and will remember their sins no more.”**

**13 By calling this covenant “new,” he has made the first
one obsolete; and what is obsolete and outdated will
soon disappear.**
