## QUESTIONS TO PROCESS IN LIFEGROUPS

Read together:

Romans 5:6-10

2 Corinthians 5:21

1. In your own words, what has Jesus provided for you through the cross?

2. Have you ever attempted to "pay" for the guilt of your own sin? How'd that work out?

3. Do you struggle with condemnation?

4. In what areas of your life are you being defeated? How can you apply the power and victory of the cross to those places?

## PRAY IN LIFEGROUPS

1. Pray that the Lord would remind us of what our lives would be like without the power of the cross.

2. Pray for a deep sense of gratitude for the cross to rise up

and for power to live the exchanged life.

3. Pray we will enjoy the abundant, healed and forgiven life Jesus purchased for everyone who accepts his perfect sacrifice.

1. Watch the video (LHC website or YouTube/search Merilee Withrow): Freedom Video 3 Jesus Rescued Me.

2. Declaration: I say YES to FREEDOM when I remember that Jesus rescued me and transferred me into his kingdom when he died on the cross.

3. Scripture: Colossians 1:13,14

4. Song: Shackles (Go Fish version – GTCIgnitekids)

1. Why did Jesus die on a cross for me?

2. What did Jesus rescue me from?

3. After God adopted me, what freedoms do I have now?

1. What do the following Scriptures say about the condition or position we're in without Christ?

2. What four things does Romans 5:6-10 speak about our condition when Christ died for us?

3. What did Jesus accomplish on the cross according to the following scriptures?:

Revelation 1:5  
Revelation 5:9  
1 John 2:2

4. Since Christ died on our behalf, what should be our response according to Romans 7:7-9?

5. Since we have been raised to life in Christ, what are we to do in regards to Colossians 3:1?

6. What has God given us in exchange for our guilt and sin according to 2 Corinthians 5:21?

7. Galatians 6:14 reminds us that because of the cross of Christ we have something to boast about, and as a result what has been crucified to us?

8. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you what he would have you apply to your personal life in light of what you just studied.

9. Write out a prayer of gratitude, for what Jesus accomplished on your behalf and also the life he has called you to in the resurrection power of Christ.
